**What are its objectives?** The current main objective of the Task Force is to prepare the participation of EYEN to the Citizens' Energy Forum, an annual gathering of consumers, regulators and industry to explore consumers' perspective in the European Energy Market. It is organised by the European Commission in Dublin and EYEN has already participated at two editions.

**What is its future?** The objective of the Task Force will grow. Some are: working towards becoming an established Commission and work with Consumer Organisations like BEUC or the European Economic and Social Committee (EESC).

### → Your role

- Realise (from choice of topic, drafting, review and finalisation) the Position Statement for EYEN at the Citizens Energy Forum, in particular taking care of the collection of inputs from Members and the sharing of drafts for approval of the Members
- Review the content of presentations and participations of other attendees at the Forum on the behalf of EYEN
- Coordinate the realisation of a database of knowledge and data on young energy consumers in Europe
- Coordinate a team of about 2 people (initially) that compose of Policy Researchers and Analysts
- Draft and update the timeline of activities
- Reporting to the Task Force Coordinator on the development of the activities

### → You are a good fit for this role if you

- You are a good communicator, you are good at summarising and have a clear communication method, you can put complex concepts in a simple and clear message
- Ideally you have experience in writing statement or public speeches and in making professional presentations, but a strong motivation to learn will be also positively considered
- You are passionate about the topic of energy, in particular you have personal or professional experience or are very motivated to learn about the energy consumer market in Europe

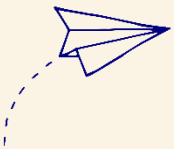
