What are its objectives? The current main objective of the Task Force is to prepare the participation of EYEN to the Citizens' Energy Forum, an annual gathering of consumers, regulators and industry to explore consumers' perspective in the European Energy Market. It is organised by the European Commission in Dublin and EYEN has already participated at two editions.

What is its future? The objective of the Task Force will grow. Some are: working towards becoming an established Commission and work with Consumer Organisations like BEUC or the European Economic and Social Committee (EESC).

→ Your role

- Follow the development of regulations on European energy consumers and related initiatives from the civil society, industry, and national regulators. In particular, all materials related to young energy consumers should be your focus – it is an innovative project and very few research of this kind has been done, thus you will lead the research questions and methodology of analysis together with the task Force Coordinator and Content Editor
- Collect your research in a knowledge database in coordination with the Content Editor – it will be up to you to organise the tasks for the creation and effective management of this database
- Direct the research field of the team with the aim of creating supportive and solid material for EYEN position statement at the Citizens' Energy Forum and any other intervention on the topic
- Report to the Content Editor and Task Force Coordinator the progress of the activities

→ You are a good fit for this role if you

- You have experience in the field of research or data analytics. Ideally you are a fresh graduate with a master degree or you are a PhD or work in a research institute or as a data analyst
- You have knowledge of statistics and the basic understanding of data management and data analysis
- You like and are capable to effectively search on the internet for information and data sources
- You are confident exploring and studying a topic you are not (yet) an expert in
- You are passionate about the topic of energy, in particular you have interest to learn about the energy consumer market in Europe and work with people of the sector

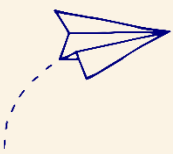
