**What are its objectives?** The current main objective of the Task Force is to prepare the participation of EYEN to the Citizens' Energy Forum, an annual gathering of consumers, regulators and industry to explore consumers' perspective in the European Energy Market. It is organised by the European Commission in Dublin and EYEN has already participated at two editions.

**What is its future?** The objective of the Task Force will grow. Some are: working towards becoming an established Commission and work with Consumer Organisations like BEUC or the European Economic and Social Committee (EESC).

### → Your role

- Coordinator of the new Young Energy Consumers Task Force
- Officially establish the Task Force in EYEN – it will be your project since the beginning
- Coordinate a team of about 5 people (initially) that include External Relations, a Content Editor, Policy Researchers and Analysts
- Take care of the timeline of activities, budget and resources management of the Task Force
- Support the communication with the European Commission regarding the Citizens' Energy Forum
- Set the agenda of the participation of EYEN at the Citizens' Energy Forum - What to present? Who to invite as speaker among Members and/or externals?
- Report to the EYEN Governing Board on the development of the Task Force activities
- Ensure that the deadlines are met, and the objectives of the Task Force are achieved

### → You are a good fit for this role if you

- Are good at summarising and have a clear communication method
- Are well organised, you respect deadlines and have a professional approach to your work
- Are skilled in horizontal leadership, and you are good at motivating people
- Are passionate about the topic of energy, and have personal or professional experience or are very motivated to learn about the energy consumer market in Europe
- Have the vision and grit to bring this Task Force to the next level, and intend to stay within EYEN for at least one full year, better if longer

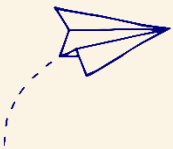
