EYEN's flagship annual event, the first **European Youth Energy Forum**, produced a position paper with 12 concrete proposals to improve youth engagement in the European energy transition. Drafted with a roadmap for implementation, presented to different stakeholders, debated between sectors, with a team working hard to make change a reality.

The COP Task Force – a quick intro

What is COP? COP is the supreme decision-making body of the UN Convention for Climate Change. The Convention meets every year to multilaterally discuss the international initiatives to tackle Climate Change. One of the most well-known results of the successful work of the Convention is the Paris Agreement, signed in 2015.

COP Task Force



What are the Task Force objectives? The current main objective of the Task Force is to prepare the participation of EYEN to the Conference of the Party (COP). First task will be to work on the long process of becoming an official observer organisation with the right to attend every year the conference. In the meanwhile, the Task Force should create a proposal and execution of impactful activities to bring to the Conference. EYEN already participated in one Conference of the Parties in 2021. On a global scale, COP is the key networking and impact catalyser event related to climate change action.

→ Your role

- Active Team Member for the ideation and execution of the EYEN event at COP28 that will take place in the United Arab Emirates between the 30th of November and the 12th of December
- Support the Coordinator in the official establishment of the Task Force in EYEN
- Support the Coordinator in leading the task for EYEN to become an official observer organisation at COP – possible from July 2023
- Provide proactive and creative solutions in the brainstorming of the event and deliver all the tasks needed for the creation of the EYEN participation event and networking strategy at COP
- Report to the Task Force Coordinator on the development of the Task Force activities
- The Task Force is composed of 4 team members that will share the roles for working on
 - partnership opportunities with relevant stakeholders to make the event successful
 - communications material to advertise the event
 - research and content creation for the event (ex. workshop preparation, data collection, preparation of presentation, etc.)

→ You are a good fit for this role if you

- Can work independently, are a native team player and have a clear communication method
- Are very creative and can think out of the box, but you are also well organised, respect deadlines and have a professional approach to your work
- Have experience in event planning
- Are curious about the young energy community and are enthusiastic about being part of it

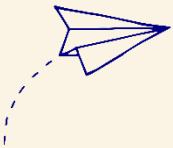
